

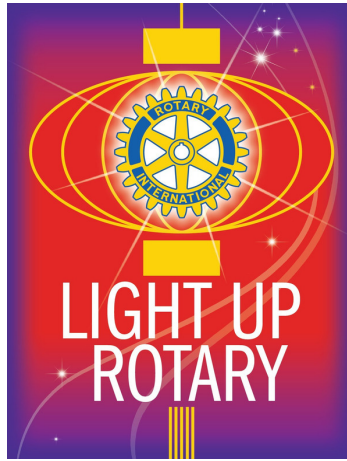

President Delores Edwards convened the annual joint meeting with the Baltimore Kiwanis club. After the usual invocation , happy dollars and fines for not wearing the Rotary Pin we introduced our visitors. The visitor that came the furthest distance was Daran Rehmeyer from Swaziland (a 16 hour flight). Daran is the president of the local rotary club in Swaziland and with his wife heads up a health services and economic development mission in Swaziland. Our club has provided some financial support through Rotary International and the Kudvumisa foundation. Daran gave us a brief update of the mission effort and the construction of a clinic building to start Jan 1, 2018.

Our main speaker was Dwight S. Warren , Executive director of the McKim Community Association, Inc. The McKim center is located at 1120 East Baltimore Street. McKim offers numerous programs for Middle and High School students includeing : a 5 week summer program, a wrestling program, an after school educational program, a track and field program, and a breakfast and lunch program. Baltimore Rotary supports the coaches club that exists at several High Schools. McKim is also partnering with Friends School for some of their programs. An excellent program that our city sorely needs.
